Spay/Neuter Program Roundup

We are excited to announce that our partner spay/neuter program with Town & Country Vet Clinic (Ogdensburg, Potsdam & Massena) has now passed **1,113** spays & neuters since August 2014! SNN is helping subsidize some supply costs and Town & Country is matching our mobile clinic package & price!

Clients eligible for SNN's mobile clinic through our application process are also eligible for this program with Town & Country. We have started a similar partner program with Dr. Liane Underwood from Little Friends Veterinary Services in Lyons Falls, NY! For applications and information, please call 315-486-0094.

2017 is also a year of milestones for Spay-Neuter-Now having reached over **18,643 lifetime program spays & neuters since 1994!** That means over 18,600 cats & dogs that have been spayed, neutered & vaccinated and an untold number of litters of litters of litters that have not been filling local shelters, succumbing to the harsh North Country winters or failing to find a good home.





Spay-Neuter-Now would also like to thank all of our mobile clinic hosts during our MASH clinic season over the winter as well as the Neuter Commuter clinics in the spring, summer and fall! Thank you all for opening your facilities for us to turn them into surgery suites for the day and helping to keep our clinic services available in your community!

Flat-fee packages include spay/neuter surgery, pain meds, rabies & distemper vaccinations, flea treatment and a check/treatment for ear mites.



Jefferson County Public Health Rabies Vaccination Collaboration

Jefferson County Public Health Service and Spay-Neuter-Now have been collaborating for the past three years to increase the rabies vaccination rates within the county. Public Health has been providing rabies vaccine and supplies to SNN to distribute as part of our mobile clinic program for the underserved populations that may not traditionally be able to seek veterinary services.

It is mandatory by law to maintain rabies vaccinations for your pets. Funds for the vaccine and supplies provided were secured by Senator Patty Ritchie as part of the North Country Low Cost Vaccine Program and resources are distributed locally.

SNN mobile clinics include both a rabies and distemper vaccination as part of our flat-fee package. Since 2011, SNN has provided over 6,000 rabies vaccinations for North Country cats and dogs. 91% of all cats and 48% of all dogs coming through our spay/neuter programs needed their rabies vaccinations.

Rabies is in the North Country. It is a serious threat to public health. Please keep your pets up to date on their vaccinations and check with your county's public health department for more information on rabies & clinics:
